Boosterthon: This year we raised over \$100,000, however under our contract with Boosterthon they kept \$49,000 of that. Since October the Executive Board, Abby Vail (Committee chair) and Mr. Crowe have done significant research and have determined that we can likely host the event ourself without the help of Boosterthon using a different software platform to collect the pledges and using more staff/school based help to collect and KEEP more funds on campus.

A motion was made by Parker Sullivan to approve leaving the Boosterthon platform and taking the fundraiser in house, Seconded by Denis Burns. A vote was conducted and this passed unanimously.

Other business: We need to discuss/vote on a Business/Community Partner of the Year. Due to a communication issue with the district, we have to make this decision today. Nominees/businesses discussed included Prime Meridian Bank, due to the fact that the school banks there, they help with Book Fair, STEAM carnival and sponsor a breakfast for faculty. Denis Burns moved to name them our partner, Seconded by Tiffany Cruz, passes unanimously.

Special Presentation from the Garden Group: They discussed their plans for curriculum, updating the garden area, and the expansion plan to include 8 raised beds in an area that's currently a dirt space. This expansion will match what we already have and make use of an otherwise relatively unused area outdoors between Kindergarten and 3rd grade buildings. The County's mason will help with this, all rotten wood pieces we have will also be replaced with brick which will last longer. This was taken under advisement by the Board and will be discussed/voted on in a coming meeting.
